How to Get your reimbursement...



Eligibility

To be eligible for reimbursement, you must:

- Be enrolled in an approved apprenticeship program
- Be working on an Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (ADOT & PF) project which has Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) assistance
- Women, minorities, or disadvantaged individuals

If you are unsure whether you meet the criteria above, please contact the Support Services Coordinator at the ADOT &PF Civil Rights Office. All contact information is listed on the back of this brochure.



Items Eligible

The following items are eligible for reimbursement:

- Union initiation fees and dues required for work under your apprenticeship program
- Work Clothing-must be appropriate for your apprentice craft.
- Child care financial assistance is available. While working or involved in activities required to fulfill your apprenticeship program.

This program is to off-set some costs associated with getting started in an apprenticeship program.



Submitting Your Request

To request reimbursement you must:

- Complete a Reimbursement Assistance for Apprentices application form:
 - The application must be signed and include back up documentation (i.e., receipts).
- \$250 per year is the maximum amount to be reimbursed
