PURPOSE

Improve safety and reduce wait times at the intersection of Chena Pump Road, Chena Small Tracts Road, and Old Chena Ridge Road.

CURRENT KEY DESIGN FEATURES

- Single lane with no bypass lanes
- Pedestrian crossings for three legs
- Install additional street lights

WHY A ROUNDABOUT?

Roundabouts are proven to reduce the likelihood of a severe crash compared to a signalized or four-way stop intersection. This is because traffic is traveling slowly and in the same direction, making severe crashes like t-bones and head-on collisions less likely to occur.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE & PHASING

We expect construction on this project to begin in 2025. Some of the construction phasing options include:

- Full intersection closure (highest traffic impact, shortest construction time)
- Fully open intersection (keeps traffic flowing, extends construction time)
- Partial intersection closure (a middle ground between traffic impacts and construction time)
